- (a) the details of various schemes being implemented by the Government for the development of animal husbandry, dairy and poultry in the State of Tamil Nadu and Odisha during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) the total number of farmers who have been benefited by these schemes so far;
- (c) whether the Government has not achieved growth rate targets in animal husbandry sector, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of corrective steps taken by the Government to boost animal husbandry sector;
- (e) whether the Government has received any proposal from the States of Tamil Nadu and Odisha regarding animal husbandry and dairy projects under the centrally sponsored schemes and if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard;

- (a) The details of the various schemes being implemented by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India for the development of animal husbandry, dairy and poultry across the country including Tamil Nadu and Odisha during the last three years and the current year are as under:
 - i. Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM),
 - ii. National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD),
 - iii. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF),
 - iv. Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDCFPO)
 - v. National Livestock Mission (NLM),
 - vi. Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF)
 - vii. Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme (LH&DCP) (wherein erstwhile Livestock Health and Disease Control Scheme and National Animal Disease Control Programme were merged with effect from 2021-22)
 - viii. Livestock Census and Integrated Sample Survey (LC & ISS)
- (b) The total number of farmers benefited under these schemes so far are as under:

- (c) No Sir, Livestock Sector in our country has been growing at a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 7.67% (at constant prices) from 2014-15 to 2021-22. Milk production has increased by 51.05% over the past 8 years from 146.3 million tonnes during 2014-15 to 221.06 million tonnes during 2021-22. Milk production is growing at the annual growth rate (CAGR) of 6.1% over the past 8 years. Egg production in the country has also increased from 78.48 billion nos. in 2014-15 to 129.60 billion nos. in 2021-22. Egg production in the country is growing at the rate (CAGR) of 7.4% per annum. Meat production in the country has increased from 6.69 million tonnes in 2014-15 to 9.29 million tonnes in 2021-22.
- (d) In order to boost growth in livestock sector, the Government is implementing various animal husbandry and dairying schemes to enhance production and productivity of bovines & small ruminants (sheep & goat), piggery & poultry. This helps in creating entrepreneurship, development of animal husbandry & dairying infrastructure, direct & indirect employment and better livelihood opportunities for unemployed youth and farmers engaged in cattle, dairy, poultry, sheep, goat, piggery, feed and fodder sector.

(e) Yes, Sir. The Government has received proposals from States of Tamil Nadu and Odisha regarding animal husbandry and dairy projects under variouscentrally sponsored schemes of the Department. The details of project proposals received from States are as under:
