STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (f) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 85 BY SHRI A. GANESHAMURTHI AND SHRI A. RAJA TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 26.07.2023 REGARDING OPERATION OF VANDE BHARAT TRAINS.

(a) to (f) With a view to provide better travel experience to the passengers, Indian Railways are introducing Vande Bharat trains with modern coaches having enhanced safety features and better amenities. Presently, 50 Vande Bharat Express services are being operated on the Indian Railways network, which are catering to the needs of stations located in 23 States/Union Territories. Of these 50 Vande Bharat services, 12 Vande Bharat services are catering to the Southern parts of the country which include 04 Vande Bharat services catering to the needs of the stations located in the State of Tamil Nadu. Moreover, introduction of trains including Vande Bharat services, is an ongoing process on Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic justification, etc.
