- (a) the details regarding the progress of the National Logistics Policy of India since inception in the country including the State of UP, MP and Maharashtra;
- (b) the details of the States where work has been started under the National Logistics Policy;
- (c) the details regarding the projects on which work has been completed so far under the National Logistics Policy;
- (d) the number of ministries which are currently involved with the Gati Shakti plan; and
- (e) the progress of the Integration of Digital System (IDS) under the Gati Shakti Plan?

(a) to (e): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO OF LOKSABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 90 FOR ANSWER ON 26TH JULY, 2023.

(a) & (b): The National Logistics Policy was launched on 17th September 2022, by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, with target to (i) reduce cost of logistics in India to be comparable to global benchmarks by 2030; (ii) improve the Logistics Performance Index ranking - endeavor is to be among top 25 countries by 2030; and (iii) create data driven decision support mechanism for an efficient logistics ecosystem. In addition, four initiatives under the National Logistics Policy including (i) Unified Logistics Interface Platform (ii) a digital portal for registering logistics related issues - E-LogS, (iii) E-Handbook on Warehousing Standards; (iv) training courses on PM GatiShakti on i-Got platform, were launched.

Aligned with the National Logistics Policy, 21 States have notified their respective State Logistics Policies, including the States of Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh (List of States given in **Annexure A**).

(c): In addition to the 21 State Logistics Policies notified, progress made on other important initiatives under the National Logistics Policy, include:

- i. An inter-Ministerial Services Improvement Group (SIG). has been established to address issues related to improving logistics efficiency and lowering cost;
- ii. A digital portal E-LoGs has been made operational for uploading logistics-related issues and tracking resolution;
- iii. Work has been initiated on human resources development and capacity building in the logistics sector. A training module on PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (NMP) is live on iGOT platform;
- iv. Report on LEADS (Logistics Ease Across Different States) 2021-22, which showcases States' performance in improving logistics efficiency at State-level, was launched on 13th October 2022, and is an annual exercise;
- v. Another major digital initiative that has streamlined doing business in the logistics sector and facilitated ease of logistics is the Unified Logistics Integrated Platform (ULIP). ULIP integrates 33 logistics-related digital systems /portals across Ministries / Departments and provides single sign-on to users;
- vi. Logistics Data Bank project is operational to track and trace EXIM containers. LDB is integrated with 17 ports, 91 toll plazas, 358 CFS/ICD/Empty yards, 37 special economic zones, 3 integrated check posts. More than 2750 RFID readers have been installed at all major routes and dedicated freight corridors;
- vii. A Comprehensive Port Connectivity Plan for improving the last and first mile connectivity to ports, has been notified;
- viii. An e-Handbook on Warehousing Standards that provides recommendatory standards for setting up warehouses has been launched.

(d) & (e): As on date, 39 Central Ministries (8 Infrastructure Ministries, 13 Social Sector Ministries, 18 Economic / User Ministries) are onboarded on to PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (NMP). List of Ministries onboarded is given in the **Annexure - B**.

Individual portals with regard to States and Ministries have also been integrated with digital system of PM GatiShakti.
