INTRODUCTION OF TRAIN NO. 54377/54378

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken or proposes to take any steps to reintroduce the plying of train number 54377/54378, which used to run from Bareilly to Prayag and is currently running from Lucknow to Prayag, and to start the plying of train number 14315/14316 Intercity Express from Shahjahanpur to New Delhi which at present is running from Bareilly to New Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has also received any proposals from public representatives in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the progress made so far in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Indian Railways have undertaken rationalization of the time table, including rationalization of train services, in a scientific manner with the assistance of IIT-Bombay. The exercise has been undertaken *inter alia* to provide for better passenger safety by creating maintenance corridor blocks and speed up train services. Request from the Hon'ble Member of Parliament has been received for restoration of 54377/54378 Prayagraj Sangam-Bareilly Passenger. Presently, Bareilly-Shahjahanpur sector is very well served by 41 pairs of train services. Besides, extension of train services is an on-going process on Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic justification etc.
