#### **AUTOMOBILE INDUSTRIAL UNITS**

#### 1024. SHRI JUAL ORAM:

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state: वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री

- (a) whether the Government has a proposal to set up new automobile industrial units in different States:
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof; and
- (c) the funds earmarked for the establishment of automobile industries in Odisha?

#### **ANSWER**

### वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री सोम प्रकाश) THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

(a) to (c): Industries is primarily a State subject except for the specific items mentioned in the Union List of Constitution of India. The Central Government comes out with several initiatives and policies to promote industrialization in various parts of the country from time to time. Government of India also provides a framework of reforms for improving business environment across States.

In addition to ongoing schemes of various Departments and Ministries, Government has taken various other steps to boost domestic, foreign investments in India to promote and facilitate industrial development across States/UTs. These include programs like Make in India, Start Up India, Industrial Corridors, Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI), Promoting Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) and reducing compliance burden, National Single Window System (NSWS), One District One Product (ODOP), Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) Policy Reforms, ProjectMonitoring Group to remove bottlenecks in setting up of major infrastructure projects and also by implementing Special Incentive Schemes for North Eastern and Himalayan Regions, etc.

Further, Ministry of Heavy Industries is implementing two Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Schemes to incentivize Auto Industry on Pan India basis. The budgetary outlay of PLI Auto is Rs.25938 crore and PLI, ACC (Advanced Chemistry Cell) is Rs.18,100 crore.
