Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

(a) the details of beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY) in the country especially in the State of Maharashtra and Punjab including district-wise details since its inception;

(b) the number of beneficiaries registered under PM-GKAY in Maharashtra and Rajasthan;

(c) the quantum of foodgrains given to each person in a month under the PM-GKAY scheme in Maharashtra and Rajasthan in 2021-22;

(d) the details of foodgrains allocated to Maharashtra and Rajasthan in 2021-22, in terms of metric tonnes;

(e) the quantity of rice supplied and subsidy given to Maharashtra and Rajasthan under the scheme, year-wise and phase-wise; and

(f) the details of price at which rice is given to Maharashtra and Rajasthan under different PDS schemes?

(a) & (b): In view of the pro-poor initiative announced by the Govt. of India to ameliorate the hardship faced by the poor due to economic disruption caused by Corona virus, this Department has implemented Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY) in seven (7) phases from April 2020 to December 2022. This Department has allocated additional free-of-cost foodgrains to all States/UTs for distribution to around 80 Crore National Food Security Act (NFSA) beneficiaries in the country, including Maharashtra, Punjab & Rajasthan. Further, since 1st January 2023, the Government of India has decided to distribute free-of-cost foodgrains to all NFSA beneficiaries till 31st December 2023. As conveyed by the concerned State Government, the district-wise details of NFSA beneficiaries of Maharashtra, Punjab & Rajasthan are placed at Annexure-I (a, b & c).

(c): During 2021-22, total 5kg of foodgrains per person per month have been provided free-of-cost to National Food Security Act (NFSA) beneficiaries in all States/UTs (including Maharashtra and Rajasthan) under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY).

(d): Details of foodgrains (rice / wheat) allocated to Maharashtra & Rajasthan in terms of Metric Tones (MT), year-wise & phase-wise manner under PM-GKAY are attached as Annexure-II.

(e): The details of quantity of rice supplied and subsidy released to Maharashtra and Rajasthan under the PM-GKAY scheme during FY2020-21 to FY2022-23 are attached as Annexure-III.

(f): Free-of-cost foodgrains have been allocated to all States/UTs under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY) except the UTs which have opted for Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT).
