CSR IN UDAIPUR

Will the Minister of MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the companies working under the Ministry of Mines have performed the work for social upliftment under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) in Udaipur Parliamentary Constituency as per the rules prescribed by the Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the company-wise and item-wise details of such work for social upliftment; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): There are three Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSE) under the Ministry of Mines viz. National Aluminium Company Limited (NALCO) with operational units mostly in Odisha; Hindustan Copper Limited (HCL) with operational units in Gujarat, Rajasthan (Khetri), Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra; and Mineral Exploration and Consultancy Limited (MECL) located in Nagpur with pan India operations involving exploration of minerals at remote locations.

The CPSEs undertake Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities mostly in the vicinity of their operational units. However, MECL has donated one (01) Force Motor Ambulance to Medical Superintendent, Late Shri Khemraj Katara, Rajkiya Satellite Hospital, Hiranmagri, Udaipur worth Rs. 17.66 Lakh under its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programme for the Financial Year 2022-23
