- (a) the number of vacancies created by the Union Government in various Government departments for the educated unemployed youth of the country during the last ten years, department-wise;
- (b) whether due to non-recruitment in regular government jobs, the number of educated unemployed is increasing day by day and if so, the details thereof along with the reasons for not advertising the vacancies in the said Government departments;
- (c) whether lakhs of applications are being received for a small number of vacancies/posts and the number of candidates prossessing much higher qualification than the essential qualification among them is very high; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): Occurrence and filling up of vacancies is a continuous process, as per the requirement of various Ministries/ Departments/Organizations of Central Government. Vacancies in various Ministries/Departments of the Central Government, their attached/subordinate offices arise due to retirement, promotion, resignation, death etc. Government has already issued instructions to all Ministries/ Departments for timely filling up of the unfilled posts. Rozgar Melas, being organized by Government of India, are expected to act as catalyst in further employment generation and provide meaningful opportunities to the youth for their empowerment and participation in National Development directly.
