- (a) the objectives and merits of PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP) for multimodal connectivity in the country;
- (b) the details of progress made under PM Gati Shakti NMP;
- (c) the details and number of major projects identified by various Departments/Ministries under the scheme and the estimated cost in this regard?;
- (d) the quantum of funds for the projects started in the State of Uttar Pradesh; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken for integrated planning and coordinated execution of infrastructure projects in a time-bound manner?

ANSWER

(a), (b) & (e): PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP) is a transformative approach for integrated and holistic planning across concerned Ministries/Departments to improve multimodal connectivity, logistics efficiency and to address critical infrastructure gaps for seamless movement of people and goods, with a focus on minimising disruptions and ensuring timely completion of projects.

PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP) has digital component in the form of a GIS (Geographic Information System) based platform which integrates the geospatial data related to the infrastructure in the country and planning portals of various Ministries/Departments of the Government. This was launched in October, 2021 with the objectives viz, facilitating data-based decision-making for integrated planning, prioritisation of projects, synchronised implementation, optimisation of cost, time and project monitoring.

Under the PM Gati Shakti initiative, 85 major infrastructure (c) & (d): projects have been identified bv various Ministries/Departments which have been seen by the Network Planning Group (NPG). The estimatedcost of these projects is about Rs. 5.40 Lakh Crores. Further, the States have identified 205 infrastructure projects under PM GatiShakti, with estimated cost of Rs. 5,496 Crores, under "Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2022-23."

For enhanced capital expenditure by States for infrastructure development, the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure through part-II (for PM-Gati Shakti related expenditure) of the "Schemefor Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2022-23" has made an additional provision of Rs. 5000 crores for disbursement among the States as long term loans at a zero interest rate, of which Rs 896.91 crores for 15 projects had been approved for Uttar Pradesh.
