**PIPED WATER SUPPLY**

1154. SHRI KANUMURU RAGHU RAMA KRISHNA RAJU:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government's Mission to ensure piped water supply to all rural households by 2024 is being implemented as per the schedule;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the status and progress of the mission as on date along with the funds sanctioned and released so far in the state of Andhra Pradesh?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal in partnership with States, to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household in the country, by 2024. Water is a state subject and therefore the primary responsibility for planning and implementing piped water supply schemes to provide tap water to their households, lies with the respective State/UT. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical and financial assistance under JJM.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, 3.23 Crore (17%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections in the country. Since then, tap water connections have been provided to additional 9.40 Crore rural households. Thus, as on 24.07.2023, out of 19.46 Crore rural households in the country, provision of tap water supply has been made to 12.63 Crore (64.90%) households.

As on 24.07.2023, the States of Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Telangana, and UTs of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, and Puducherry reported to have provided tap water connection to every rural household in their State/UT. The remaining States/UTs have been advised to cover all their rural households within the mission period.

(c) As reported by Andhra Pradesh, at the time of launch of Jal Jeevan Mission in the State on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2019, 30.74 lakh (32.18%) households had tap water connections. Since then, 36.20 lakhs additional households have been provided with tap water connections. Thus, as on

24.07.2023, the provision of tap water supply is available to 66.94 lakhs (70.07%) households in the State.
