Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has unveiled a mobile app specifically designed for street vendors to ease their loan application process and if so, the details thereof:
- (b) whether launch of mobile app would eliminate unnecessary paperwork and would ensure a smooth and efficient experience for street vendors and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of persons who have been sanctioned the loan and disbursed under PM-SVANidhi scheme in the country during each of the last three years, State-wise, particularly in the State of Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands:
- (d) the total number of vendors targeted to be provided benefits under this scheme by December, 2023;
- (e) the constraints faced by the Government while implementing PM SVANidhi scheme;
- (f) the details of positive impact on street vendors after the implementation of PM SVANidhi-scheme; and
- (g) the steps taken by the Government for financial inclusion of more and more vendors and also for improvement of their living conditions?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

- (a) & (b): Yes Sir. Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) has launched Mobile app of PM SVANidhi for street vendors (SVs) on 1st June, 2023. With the help of mobile app, Street Vendor (SV) can apply for loan and Letter of Recommendation (LoR) under PM SVANidhi Scheme. The SV can also check their loan application status and cashback history.
- (c): The details of number of beneficiaries who have been sanctioned the loan and disbursed under PM-SVANidhi scheme in the country during each of the last three years, State-wise, including State of Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Odisha and Andaman & Nicobar Islands is at Annexure-I.
- (d): As per the decision of the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs dated 26.04.2022, the target set under PM SVANidhi Scheme for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd loans is 42 Lakh, 12 Lakh and 3 Lakh respectively by December, 2024.
- (e) & (f): Prime Minister Street Vendor's AtmaNirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi) Scheme was launched with the objective of facilitating collateral free working capital loan to street vendors to restart their businesses. As on July 20, 2023 the scheme has successfully disbursed 50.63 lakh loans, amounting to ₹6,492.02 Cr., to 38.53 lakh street vendors.
- (g): The PM SVANidhi Scheme has been made available to all street vendors vending in urban areas. Further, the lending under the Scheme has been extended from March, 2022 to December, 2024. This would help in getting more and more vendors under the ambit of the Scheme.
- 'SVANidhi se Samriddhi' component under the PM SVANidhi Scheme, launched on 04 January, 2021, to build safety net for the beneficiaries' families for improving their living conditions.

It links the beneficiaries families to existing eight welfare schemes of the Government of India, targeting their holistic development and socio-economic upliftment. These schemes are PM Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana, PM Suraksha Bima Yojana, PM Jan Dhan Yojana, One Nation One Ration Card, PM Shram Yogi Maandhan Yojana, Registration under Building and other Construction Workers (BoCW), Janani Suraksha Yojana and PM Matru Vandana Yojana.
