**GOAL SET UNDER JJM**

†1217. SHRIMATI REKHA VERMA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government aims through Jal Jeevan Mission to supply safe and affordable drinking water to rural households and manage the water supply systems in the villages by the year 2024;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal in partnership with States, to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household in the country. Water is a state subject and therefore the primary responsibility for planning and implementing piped water supply schemes to provide tap water to their households, lies with the respective State/UT. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical and financial assistance.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, 3.23 Crore (17%) households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, tap water connections have been provided to additional 9.40 Crore rural households. Thus, as on 24.07.2023, out of 19.46 Crore rural households in the country, provision of tap water supply has been made to 12.63 Crore (64.90%) households.

As on 27.07.2023, the States of Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Telangana and UTs of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, and Puducherry reported to have provided tap water connection to every rural household in their State/UT. The remaining States/UTs have been advised to cover all their rural households within the mission period. The status of tap connections to rural households as reported by States/ UTs on JJM dashboard as on date, is at **Annex**.
