Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is cognizant of the progress of the implementation of the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) in the cities of Visakhapatnam, Kakinada, Tirupati and Amaravati in Andhra Pradesh;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;**
- (c) whether the Government is of the intent of implementing round five of SCM; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a) & (b) : Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. In the State of Andhra Pradesh, 4 cities i.e., Amaravati, Kakinada, Tirupati & Visakhapatnam have been selected for development as Smart Cities. Details of physical and financial progress in Smart Cities of Andhra Pradesh are given below : -
