#### GAS CONNECTIONS UNDER PMUY

### †1319. SHRI KAUSHALENDRA KUMAR:

### Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of gas connections distributed under the Government's ambitious Ujjawala Yojana, State-wise;
- (b) the number of active gas connections at present; State-wise;
- (c) the amount of subsidy being provided by the Government on LPG at present as compared to the last 10 years;
- (d) the number of subsidised and non-subsidised gas connections in the country, State-wise;
- (e) whether the number of refills in rural areas has decreased drastically due to increased price of gas and consumers have been forced to use wood as fuel; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

# पेट्रोलियम एवं प्राकृतिक गैस मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री रामेश्वर तेली) MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

- (a) & (b) As on 01.07.2023, there are total 31.50 crore active domestic LPG consumers including 9.59 crore PMUY beneficiaries across the country. State-wise details are at **Annexure-I**.
- (c) The details of subsidy on domestic LPG given by Government during the last 10 years are at **Annexure-II**.
- (d) Out of total 31.5 crore domestic LPG consumer in the country, 29.13 crore consumers are cash-transfer compliant as per DBTL scheme and the applicable subsidy is credited to their bank account directly. Government provides subsidised domestic LPG only upto 12 refills of 14.2 kg per year.
- (e) & (f) LPG consumption of PMUY beneficiaries is monitored on regular basis. Consumption of domestic LPG by households depends on several factors like food habits, household size, cooking habits, price, availability of alternate fuels etc. Per capita consumption of PMUY beneficiaries (in terms of no. of 14.2 kg LPG cylinders taken per year) has increased from 3.01 (FY 2019-20) to 3.71 (FY 2022-23). Further, the Government has taken several steps to encourage consumption of LPG, which include targeted subsidy of Rs. 200/- per 14.2 Kg refill upto 12 refills/year for PMUY beneficiaries for year 2022-23 and 2023-24, option of 5 Kg Double Bottle Connection (DBC), swap option from 14.2 kg to 5 Kg, upto 3 free refills to PMUY beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package from April 2020 to December 2020 etc.
