FUNDS UNDER PMAY-U

NO. 1323. DR. KALANIDHI VEERASWAMY:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the features of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban (PMAY-U);
- (b) the funds allocated and utilized under the PMAY-U in Tamil Nadu, district-wise during the last four years;
- (c) the details and number of houses constructed for the beneficiaries under the PMAY-U during the last four years in Tamil Nadu, district-wise;
- (d) the total number of beneficiaries presently in the waiting list under the scheme at present in Tamil Nadu, district-wise; and
- (e) the time by which these are likely to be covered?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

- (a): Land and Colonization are State subjects. However, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), under the vision of 'Housing for All', supplements the efforts of States/ Union Territories (UTs), including the State of Tamil Nadu, by providing Central Assistance under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana- Urban (PMAY-U), for construction of houses for all eligible beneficiaries in urban areas since 25.06.2015. The salient features of PMAY-U are as follows:
- i. The scheme is implemented through four verticals i.e. Beneficiary-Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP),

In-Situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) and Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS).

ii. The Mission covers the entire urban area consisting of Statutory Towns, Notified Planning Areas, Development areas falling under the jurisdiction of Special Area Development Authorities, Industrial Development Authorities or any such authority under State legislation which is entrusted with the functions of urban planning & regulations.

- iii. All houses under PMAY-U have basic amenities like toilet, water supply, electricity and kitchen.
- iv. The Mission promotes women empowerment by providing the ownership of houses in name of female member or in joint name.
- v. Preference is also given to differently-abled persons, senior citizens, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Minority, single women, transgender and other weaker & vulnerable sections of the society.
- vi. A comprehensive and Robust MIS System is in place that helps all stakeholders to seamlessly manage information pertaining to physical and financial progress including storing various records through digitisation such as Survey, Project information, Beneficiary details, fund utilisation etc. All houses under BLC/AHP/ISSR are geo-tagged to track actual progress on ground.
- vii. MoHUA has set up a Technology Sub-Mission (TSM) under PMAY-U to facilitate adoption of modern, innovative and green technologies and building materials for faster and quality construction of houses.
 - (b) & (c): District -wise details of Central Assistance sanctioned, released and utilised, number of houses sanctioned, grounded and completed in Tamil Nadu under PMAY-U during the last four years are at Annexure.
 - (d) & (e): Under PMAY-U, States/UTs have assessed their actual demand of housing and prepared project proposals accordingly. Such proposals with due approval of State Level Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee (SLSMC), have been submitted to this Ministry in phased manner for consideration of Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee (CSMC) seeking admissible Central assistance.

Based on the project proposals submitted by the State of Tamil Nadu, 6.81 lakh houses have been sanctioned under PMAY-U as on 10.07.2023. Of the sanctioned houses, 6.47 lakh houses have been grounded for construction; of which 5.30 lakh are completed/ delivered to beneficiaries. PMAY-U scheme period has been extended up to 31st December, 2024, except Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS) vertical, to complete the sanctioned houses in States/ UTs without changing the funding pattern and implementation methodology. States/ UTs, including the State of Tamil Nadu, have been advised to expedite the construction of sanctioned houses so that all houses are completed within the stipulated timeline as per Detailed Project Reports. No project proposal from the State of Tamil Nadu is pending for consideration in the Ministry.
