Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of domestic airlines operating in the country, their market share, the time since operating along with number of employees engaged by each domestic airline;
- (b) the number of domestic airlines functioning in Tamil Nadu alongwith number of air passenger who have travelled in these domestic airlines during last three years;
- (c) whether any of these airlines has discontinued operations and if so, the details thereof along with number of employees rendered jobless by each of these airlines;
- (d) whether most of the domestic airlines are incurring losses and profit earned has also drastically reduced during each of the last three years and if so, the details therefor and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether the Government has any proposal to give incentives to domestic airlines for operating to and from certain regional and remote areas and if so, the details thereof along with remote areas to be connected with air routes?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

- (a):The details of the domestic airlines which have been issued Air Operator Certificate (AOC) by Directorate General of Civil Aviation(DGCA) to start the operations in the country are at Annexure-I. The details of market share of the Scheduled Indian Airlines are at Annexure-II. Number of Personnel of Scheduled Indian Airlines during last three years are at Annexure-III.
- (b): The number of domestic airlines functioning in Tamil Nadu along with number of air passengers (Domestic and International) is at Annexure IV.
- (c): List of the Airlines which discontinued operations during last 5 years is at Annexure-V.;

(d): Details of the Financial Performance of the Scheduled Indian Airlines during last three years are at Annexure-VI.;

(e): Ministry of Civil Aviation launched Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) on 21-10-2016 to stimulate regional air connectivity and make air travel affordable for the masses. The UDAN scheme envisages providing connectivity to unserved and underserved airports of the country through revival of the existing airstrips and airports. Financial Support to the Selected Airline Operators is in the form of Viability Gap Funding (VGF). State Governments provide 20% share towards VGF for RCS flights pertaining to their states. However, the share of VGF for North-Eastern states and the Union Territories is 10%.
