PENDING PROJECTS UNDER SCM

NO. 1339. SHRI RAJAN VICHARE:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of projects pending in Maharashtra, especially in Thane district under the Smart City Mission (SCM);**
- (b) the expected date of completion of the said works alongwith the details thereof; and**
- (c) the funds allocated to Maharashtra under the SCM during the last five years, year-wise?**

(a) to (c) : Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. The 8 cities i.e. Aurangabad, Kalyan-Dombivali, Nagpur, Nashik, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Pune, Solapur and Thane have been selected for development as Smart Cities in Maharashtra.

As on 7 July 2023, out of 318 projects being implemented by Smart Cities in Maharashtra; 245 projects have been completed and 73 projects are at different stages of implementation. Thane Smart City is implementing 52 projects; of which 41 projects have been completed and 11 projects are at different stages of implementation. The period of implementation of SCM has been extended up to June 2024 and all Smart Cities, including those in Maharashtra, are expected to complete their projects within the stipulated time.

As on 20 July 2023, ₹ 6,226.15 crore has been released for 8 Smart Cities in Maharashtra of which ₹ 5,756.55 crore (92%) has been utilized. Year-wise details of funds released for the Smart Cities in Maharashtra are given below

:-
