PNEUMOCOCCAL CONJUGATE VACCINE UNDER UIP

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to implement nationwide immunization of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV) under Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) as part of the "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav";
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the vaccines administered since its inception, State/UT-wise and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of UIP in West Bengal, district-wise including the north and south Dinajpur districts;
- (d) whether the Government has received any financial support from the World Health Organisation (WHO) for PCV immunization in the country;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the efforts made/proposed to be made by the Government in this regard and to safeguard the children from early age lung infections; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes to include indigenous vaccine manufacturers in PCV immunization programme and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. SATYA PAL SINGH BAGHEL)

- (a) Government of India has rolled out nationwide expansion of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV) under Universal Immunisation Programme (UIP) in October 2021 as a part of "Azadi ka Amrit Maotsay"
- (b) and (c) The number of PCV doses administered since its introduction, state-wise and the number of PCV doses administered in West Bengal, district-wise including the North and South Dinajpur districts is placed at Annexure 1 and Annexure II respectively.

- (d) and (e) Government has not received any financial support from World Health Organization (WHO) for the PCV immunization in the country. However, in kind support for the introduction of PCV was received from Global Alliance for Vaccine and Immunization (GAVI) under Health System Strengthening (HSS)-II. Thereafter, the vaccine procurement has been supported from domestic budget. To safeguard the children from early age lung infections and to reduce morbidity and mortality from childhood pneumonia, Government has also launched Social Awareness and Actions to Neutralize Pneumonia Successfully (SAANS) initiative in 2019.
- (f) PCV administered under UIP is procured from indigenous vaccine manufacturers since February 2021.
