## **Cancellation of License of Pharma Companies**

#### 1421. SHRI MANICKAM TAGORE B.:

## Will the Minister of **CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the license of 18 Pharma companies have been cancelled and some firms have been directed to stop manufacturing on account of poor quality medicines;
- (b) if so the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is true that the Government inspected 76 Pharma companies and 26 of them were served a show cause notice;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether it is a fact that the World Health Organisation have warned against some Pharma companies in India; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

- (a) to (d): Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) has informed that in order to assess the regulatory compliance of drug manufacturing premises in the country, the **Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation(CDSCO)** along with State Drugs Controllers (SDCs) have conducted risk-based inspections of 137 premises and based on findings, actions like issuance of stop production order, suspension, cancellation of licences /product licenses etc. have been taken by the concerned State Licensing Authority as per the provisions of the Drugs Rules 1945.
- (e) to (f): Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) has informed that World Health Organization (WHO) has issued Alerts with reference to 6 Indian Pharmaceutical firms between October 2022 and July 2023.

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
