- (a) the number of Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centre established in the country, State/UT-wise and specifically in Pratapgarh, Deoria and Jhansi district of Uttar Pradesh, Pali district of Rajasthan and Dewas district of Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) the total number of Ayushman Bharat Health accounts created, State/UT-wise and specifically in said districts;
- (c) whether the Government is taking steps to disseminate the information about the said Scheme to the citizens; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b). As on 24.07.2023, a total of 1,60,480 Ayushman Bharat – Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) have been operationalized in India by upgrading existing SHCs and PHCs to deliver Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) that includes preventive, promotive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative services which are universal, free, and closer to the community.

As on 24.07.2023, a total 43,27,71,870 ABHA Numbers have been created.
