Provision of subsidised fertilizers to farmers

1488: SHRIMATI SUMALATHA AMBAREESH:

Will the Minister of **CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any steps and measures have been taken by the Government to provide subsidised fertilizers to farmers in the country:
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any initiatives to provide subsidised fertilizers to sugar cane farmers of Mandya district in Karnataka; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The following steps are taken by the Government every season to meet the adequate and timely requirement of fertilizers in the country including the state of Karnataka:
- i. Before the commencement of each cropping season, Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (DA&FW), in consultation with all the State Governments, assesses the state-wise & month-wise requirement of fertilizers.
- ii. On the basis of requirement projected, Department of Fertilizers allocates sufficient/ adequate quantities of fertilizers to States by issuing monthly supply plan and continuously monitors the availability.
- iii. The movement of all major subsidized fertilizers is monitored throughout the country by an on-line web based monitoring system called integrated Fertilizer Monitoring System (iFMS);
- iv. The State Governments are regularly advised to coordinate with manufacturers and importers of fertilizers for streamlining the supplies.
- v. Regular Weekly Video Conference is conducted jointly by DA&FW and DoF with State Agriculture Officials and corrective actions are taken to dispatch fertilizers as indicated by the State Governments.

- vi. The gap between demand (requirement) and production of fertilizers is met through imports. The import for the season is also finalized well in advance to ensure timely availability.
- (c) & (d): No, Sir. The mandate of Department of Fertilizers is to ensure comfortable availability of fertilizers at state level. However, it is the mandate of state governments to monitor inter-state transition and ensure comfortable availability of fertilizers at district level.
