HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE

1493. SHRI RAMESH CHANDER KAUSHIK:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the district-wise/region-wise details of the coverage of health insurance in Haryana especially in Sonapat district;
- (b) the district-wise details of the percentage of lives covered under health insurance in Haryana especially in rural areas;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to resolve the problem of inadequate coverage of health insurance in Haryana especially in rural areas; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): District-wise details of Ayushman cards created under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), implemented in convergence with Haryana State scheme "Comprehensive Health Insurance of Antyodaya Units" (CHIRAYU), are at **Annexure**. Under the converged scheme, a total of 47.18 lakh families are eligible for healthcare benefits, out of which 17.24 lakh families are supported by Central and State Government. The balance of 29.94 lakh families are supported exclusively by the State Government.

As on 25th July 2023, a total of 85.14 lakh Ayushman cards have been created in the State of Haryana, out of which 4.32 lakh Ayushman cards have been created in Sonapat district. District-level target is a function of restructuring of district-wise beneficiary.

Flexibility has been provided to States/UTs to use non-SECC beneficiary family database for tagging against the leftover (unauthenticated) SECC families. Accordingly, many States have shared database of poor and vulnerable families against unidentified SECC families. These databases have been integrated with NHA's IT system for card creation.
