PERFORMANCE OF NUTRITION CAMPAIGN

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted detailed State-wise study of performance/effect of nutrition campaign and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the objectives achieved under nutrition campaign in Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh, District-wise;
- (c) the details regarding rate of dwarfism, malnutrition, anaemia, low birth weight among infants, children, girl child and women during tenure of nutrition campaign in the said States, district-wise;
- (d) the details of funds released and utilised for the purpose, State-wise; and
- (e) the number of beneficiaries under the said scheme in Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh, district and the tehsil-wise particularly in Prayagraj and Badaun districts of Uttar Pradesh?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT

(a) & (b) POSHAN Abhiyaan was launched on 8th March 2018 with an aim to achieve improvement in nutritional status of Children under 6 years, Adolescent Girls, Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers in a time bound manner by adopting a synergised and result oriented approach.

A novel feature of POSHAN Abhiyaan has been its focus on Community Mobilization and Awareness Advocacy leading to Jan Andolan to educate the people on nutritional aspects. Jan Andolans are considered as the biggest "Nutrition Campaigns" initiated under POSHAN Abhiyaan. These Jan Andolans are conducted annually in form of Poshan Maah and Poshan Pakhwada in the months of September and March-April respectively.

Since the launch of POSHAN Abhiyaan in March 2018, these events have helped in reaching out to communities for sensitisation on Nutrition through variety of campaigns. The Poshan Maah and Poshan Pakhwada celebrated so far have witnessed wide participation and enthusiasm from convergent Ministries, States/UTs and field functionaries. Over the years, themes have included overall nutrition, hygiene, water and sanitation, anaemia prevention, importance of breast-feeding, growth monitoring, role of Poshan Panchayats, AYUSH for Well-being, 'Back to Basics – Yoga for Health', importance of Poshan Vatikas for cultivation of local vegetables, medicinal plants/herbs and fruits at the community level, *Poshan ke Paanch Sutra*,

promoting tribal foods etc. So far, through ten such National Campaigns, more than 60 crore sensitisation activities on Nutrition have been conducted. The no. of activities reported by Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh for all the “Nutrition Campaigns” are at **Annexure-I**.

The performance/effective implementation of the programme is monitored regularly through a robust ICT platform named Poshan Tracker which captures near real-time data of the programme implementation throughout the country. It facilitates monitoring of the activities of the Anganwadi Centre (AWC), service deliveries of Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) and complete beneficiary management for pregnant women, lactating mothers and children on defined indicators

Development Monitoring & Evaluation Office (DMEO) under NITI Aayog has conducted Sectoral Evaluation of schemes including POSHAN Abhiyaan, wherein performance of the scheme was found satisfactory in criterions of Relevance, Sustainability and Equity. NITI Aayog assessed the implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan since its inception and came out with the following key findings:

- Poshan Abhiyaan has helped to bring a strong focus on improving nutrition outcomes during the first 1,000 days.
- Poshan Abhiyaan has enabled a nation-wide Jan-andolan catalysing nutrition related behaviour change at scale for positive impact on feeding and healthcare practices.
- Poshan Abhiyaan demonstrated that the processes for inter-sectoral convergence are effectively operationalized through in place institutional mechanisms at multiple levels.
- Poshan Abhiyaan showed that technology can be leveraged for real-time monitoring of large scale health and nutrition programmes.
- Poshan Abhiyaan supported the resilience of health and nutrition systems during covid-19 pandemic.

(c) The data on nutrition indicators is captured under the National Family Health Surveys conducted periodically by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. As per the latest round of NFHS-5 (2019-21), the prevalence of Low birth weight was 20% and 20.2% in Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh respectively. The prevalence of Anaemia, Stunting, Wasting and Underweight in Girl Child (under 5 years) was 68.6%, 34%, 24% and 34.2% respectively in Maharashtra and 65.9%, 38.8%, 16.6% and 31.1% respectively in Uttar Pradesh. The district-wise prevalence of stunting, underweight, wasting, anaemia, among children and women from NFHS-5 as per information provided by Health Statistics division of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare is at **Annexure-II**.

(d) The State/UT-wise details of funds released and utilised under POSHAN Abhiyaan is placed at **Annexure-III**.

(e) The details of district-wise number of beneficiaries under Poshan Abhiyaan in Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh district are at **Annexure-IV** and project-wise details of beneficiaries in Prayagraj and Badaun districts of Uttar Pradesh are at **Annexure-V**.
