Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether MBBS course has been started in Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Medical Sciences and Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital during the last four years, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether MBBS course has started there since 2019 but the construction of college building has not been completed till date or the construction process started;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the manner in which teaching is being carried out without a building for the last four years;
- (e) whether teaching of MBBS course can be carried out without a building in such an important institute; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): MBBS Course has been started in Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Medical Science and Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital (ABVIMS & Dr. RMLH), New Delhi from the year 2019-2020 with the intake of 100 students.

(d) to (f): The Dissection Hall, Lecture Theatres, laboratories and all necessary requirements for MBBS teaching have been built in the existing campus of ABVIMS & Dr. RMLH by renovating the available old structure as per the immediate need for MBBS course based on National Medical Commission (NMC) guidelines.
