ALLOCATION AND UTILIZATION OF FUNDS

1581. SHRI PRATAPRAO PATIL CHIKHLIKAR:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds released by the Ministry to Maharashtra;
- (b) the details of the fund spent in Maharashtra during the last three years, districtwise:
- (c) the details of the funds allocated for resolving the complications related to child birth among women in Nanded; and
- (d) the details of the women and child development projects being undertaken by the Government across the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) to (d) For better implementation and efficient monitoring, all Centrally Sponsored Schemes of the Ministry being implemented in all districts of Maharashtra, including Nanded, have been clubbed into three verticals, viz. (1) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 for improving nutrition indicators in the country (2) Mission Shakti, for safety, protection and empowerment of women; and (3) Mission Vatsalya, for protection and welfare of children. The details of these schemes are as under:
- (i) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0: This programme has been reorganized into 3 primary verticals: (i) Nutrition Support for POSHAN and for Adolescent Girls (ii) Early Childhood Care and Education [3-6 years] and (iii) Anganwadi Infrastructure including modern, upgraded Saksham Anganwadis.
- (ii) Mission Shakti: Mission Shakti comprises of two sub-schemes 'Sambal' and 'Samarthya' for safety and security of women and empowerment of women respectively. The existing schemes of One Stop Centres (OSC), Women Helplines (181-WHL) and Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) have been made part of Sambal sub- scheme; while the existing schemes of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), Ujjwala, Swadhar Greh and Working Women Hostel and National Creche Scheme have been subsumed in 'Samarthya'.

(iii) Mission Vatsalya: Under Mission Vatsalya, the Child Protection Scheme(CPS) has been strengthened for better outreach and protection for children in need and care in a mission mode with the objective to: (i)Support and sustain Children in difficult circumstances. (ii) Develop context-based solutions for holistic development of children from varied backgrounds. (iii) Provide scope for green field projects for encouraging innovative solutions. (iv) Cement convergent action by gap funding, if required.

The details of funds released under the aforementioned schemes to Maharashtra is annexed at **Annexure-I**.

Only under 2 schemes of Mission Shakti, funds were directly released to districts of Maharashtra viz. One Stop Centre (OSC) and Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) during the last three years. District-wise details of funds released and utilised under the schemes of OSC and BBBP during the last three years is annexed at **Annexure-II**.
