1583. DR. (PROF.) KIRIT PREMJIBHAI SOLANKI:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Jan Aushadhi Kendras in India, State-wise particularly in the State of Gujarat and regions dominated by SCs/STs and tribals;

(b) the number of new PMBJKs proposed to be opened, State-wise in 2023-24, specifically in the State of Gujarat and regions belonging to SCs/STs and tribals;

(c) the details of the budget allocation for the opening of new PMBJKs and the funds utilised for the said purpose till date, in the States across the country for the year 2023-24 specifically Gujarat and regions dominated by SCs/STs and tribals;

(d) the details of the incentives proposed to be given to the owners of PMBJKs specially those belonging to SCs/STs and tribals; and

(e) the number of operational PMBJKs in each State of the country and the amount of medicinal drugs that were sold in the year of 2022?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

(a): Under *Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana* (PMBJP), till 30.06.2023, about 9,512 *Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras* (PMBJKs) have been opened across the country, including about 526 PMBJKs in the state of Gujarat covering all regions of the state. State/UT- wise list of PMBJKs is enclosed as **Annexure.**

(b): Government has set a target to open 10,000 PMBJKs by March, 2024. No State/UT or category-wise targets have, however, been kept.

(c): The details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under the scheme during the financial year 2023-24, till 30.06.2023 are as under:

No State/UT- wise budget/ utilization targets have, however, been kept.

(d): PMBJK owners are provided an incentive up to Rs. 5.00 lakh @ 15% of monthly purchases made by them, subject to a ceiling of Rs. 15,000/- per month. Further, one-time incentive of Rs. 2.00 lakh is provided to the PMBJKs opened in North-Eastern States, Himalayan areas, Island territories and areas mentioned as aspirational district by NITI Aayog or opened by women entrepreneur, ex-serviceman, Divyang, SC & ST.

(e): During financial year 2022-23, total sales of about Rs. 1236.17 Crore was made through the PMBKs opened in the country.
