Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the child rights body has asked the States to map hotspots for street children specially in Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Jharkhand and North-Eastern States:
- (b) if so, the details of States which have completed the identification of hotspots, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted rescue operations for street children during the last five years;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, year-wise and State/ UT-wise;
- (e) the comparative figures of children rescued and those rehabilitated during the last five years, State/UT-wise including the said States; and
- (f) the number of children who have been kept in Child Care Institutions after the rescue during the last three years, year-wise and State/UT-wise?

#### ANSWER

### MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) & (b): Yes Sir. As per information received from National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), NCPCR has issued letters to all States/UTs for identification of Hotspots in their respective States/UTs. State/UT-wise details regarding completion of identification of hotspots are at **Annexure-I.**
- (c) & (d): As per information received from NCPCR, NCPCR has conducted rescue and rehabilitation drive during the relevant period wherein the children were rescued and further produced before the concerned Child Welfare Committee (CWC). In the year 2019, NCPCR had identified hotspots in and around Janpath and Khan Market area of Delhi and in Vidisha District of Madhya Pradesh. Thereafter, on the basis of the pilot rescue conducted, the NCPCR prepared an SOP 2.0 on Rescue and Rehabilitation of Children in Street Situations. NCPCR, in the year 2022 conducted spot field drive/survey in 7 States (Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, and West

Bengal), wherein 283 children were rescued and pan India in the year 2023, wherein 1551 children were rescued. State/UT-wise details of the same are at **Annexure-II** 

- (e) As per information received from NCPCR, NCPCR has developed a portal namely, *Bal-Swaraj CiSS* in the year 2021 wherein details of all those children who have been rescued from street situations and further rehabilitated are uploaded. State/UT-wise details of the same are at **Annexure–III**
- (f): State-wise number of children who have been kept in Child Care Institutions including Children who have been rescued under Mission Vatsalya Scheme during the last three years is at **Annexure-IV**.
