- (a) The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) monitors the trade of antiquities and art treasures within the country through Licensing officers and Registering officers working in length and breadth of country including Gujarat and Bihar. In case of craft item intended for export, ASI provides non-antiquity certificates on request.
- (b) Section 3 of the Antiquities and Art Treasure Act, 1972 prevents export of antiquities outside India.
