**ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL SANCTION FOR KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA
AT ULLIYERI CALICUT/No. OF STUDENTS**

1661. SHRI M.K. RAGHAVAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether administrative and financial sanction has been given for construction of Kendriya Vidyalaya No. 3 at Ulliyeri Calicut, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has sanctioned funds to develop Kendriya Vidyalaya No. 1 and 2 at Calicut, if so, details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has data regarding the total number of students of Central and non-Central Government employees in Kendriya Vidyalayas across India, if so, the details thereof; and;
- (d) the criteria on which funds will be allocated for students at school level for research and academics from National Research Foundation?

- (a) As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), a proposal for opening of a new Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) at Ulliyeri Calicut has been received. The proposal has discrepancies as per norms of KVS.
- (b) The budgetary support is provided to KVS on every year as Grants-in-aid on a consolidated basis for functioning of KVs and construction of KV building. Maintenance / Development of KV is a continuous process and funds are sanctioned by KVS to KVs including KV Calicut No. 1 and KV Calicut No. 2, as per requirements.
- (c) As per information received from KVS, there are 5,76,312 wards of Central Government Employees / Central Autonomous Bodies / Central Public Sector Undertakings, 2,30,132 wards of State Government Employees/ State Autonomous Bodies/ State Public Sector Undertakings, 5,64,137 wards of Non-Central Government / State Government Employees and 53,566 students in Project/ Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) Sector KVs (Priority in admission has been given to the wards of the employees of the concerned Project / IHL) in 1250 KVs functioning across the country.
- (d) The objective of National Research Foundation is to promote Research and Development (R&D) and foster a culture of research and innovation throughout India's universities, colleges, research institutions and R&D laboratories.
