Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has maintained separate details of the amount spent under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) for the Scheduled Tribes (STs) till date;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise especially for Maharashtra;

(c) whether the Government proposes to earmark some CSR amount to be spent for tribal area development; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) : No, Sir.

(b) : Does not arise. However, all data related to CSR filed by companies in the MCA21 registry, including company-wise, state-wise, district-wise and sector-wise are available in public domain at <u>www.csr.gov.in</u>.

(c) & (d): Under the Act, CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities of the company based on the recommendation of its CSR Committee. The CSR mandated companies can undertake any of the activities mentioned in Schedule VII subject to fulfillment of provisions as contained in the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. The Government does not issue any specific direction to the companies to spend in any particular geographical area or activity.
