Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of suppliers associated with TRIFED since its formation, the district-wise details of Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) the number of suppliers/organisations which are non-tribal or tribal people are working on minimum wages or monthly stipend therein;
- (c) the name of the States from where TRIFED mostly purchases supply products during the last five years including the name of supplier/amount/year/name of product; and
- (d) the details of the products purchased by TRIFED on which tribal people got maximum profit in Madhya Pradesh, district-wise?

(b): Out of 473 suppliers / organizations associated with TRIFED in Madhya Pradesh, 399 no. of suppliers are individual tribal suppliers wherein payments against supplies made by them directly goes to their individual bank accounts. Remaining 74 are SHGs / societies/ organizations wherein majority tribals are associated with them and tribals are working with them.
