(a) & (b) The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been conducting NEET (UG) Examination on behalf of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) since May 2019, as a uniform Entrance-cum-Eligibility Test for admission to undergraduate medical courses (MBBS, BDS, etc.) in all Medical Institutions across the country, as per the Norms set out in relevant Graduate Medical Regulations of Medical Council of India (MCI) (which has been replaced by National Medical Commission (NMC) w.e.f. 24.09.2020), as issued from time to time with the prior approval of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

As informed by NMC, the Core Syllabus for NEET (UG) Examination can be accessed at https://www.education.gov.in/parl_ques.

The details of Examination including the syllabus for NEET (UG) is published in information Bulletin every year as per practice.
