GST Collection

1763. SHRI MAHESH SAHOO:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total collection of Goods and Services Tax (GST) during the last five financial years, year-wise;
- (b) the amount of GST collected from Corporate and Retail sector during the same period, year and percentage-wise;
- (c) whether there has been a major hike in GST collection from the Corporate sector; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): The details of Gross Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection on all supplies (Domestic + Imports) during the last five financial years are given as under: -

(b), (c) & (d): The details of GST collected from the Corporates and traders other than corporates during the last five financial years are given as per **Annexure**. The GST collection from the Corporate sector in the FY 2018-19 was Rs. 6,36,248.61 Crores which has increased to Rs. 9,61,938.36 Crores in the FY 2022-23.
