UDAN SCHEME FOR ODISHA

- (a) the details of ongoing and completed projects under the Regional Connectivity Scheme Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagarik (RCS-Udan) in Odisha; (b) whether the Union Government proposes to launch new projects under RCS-UDAN in Odisha; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) Airstrips at Amarda, Jeypore, Jharsuguda, Rangeilunda, Rourkela and Utkela in Odisha have been identified for development under UDAN and to operate flights under this scheme. Flight operations have commenced from Jharsuguda, Jeypore and Rourkela airports after the revival of these airports. The remaining airstrips are under various stages of development
- (b) & (c): UDAN is a market driven scheme. Based on their assessment of demand on particular routes, interested airlines submit their proposals at the time of bidding under UDAN. An airport which is included in the awarded routes of UDAN and requires upgradation/development for commencement of UDAN operations, is developed under 'Revival of unserved and underserved airports' scheme.

The Government has released the fifth version of UDAN on 21.04.2023 to provide air connectivity to underserved and unserved destinations of the country, including the state of Odisha.
