SKILL DEVELOPMENT OF TRIBALS AND BACKWARD AREAS

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether programmes of skill development in areas of Organic Farming, Horticulture, Bee-keeping and Organic Dairying etc. are being run by the Government as per the needs of marginalized, scheduled tribes and extremely backward areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of employment given to people in the country particularly in Rajasthan during the last three years, State-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government is coordinating with Private and Public Sector Undertakings and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) and (b) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing various skilling schemes such as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthans (JSS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) for the skill development of youth in various sectors including Agriculture sector across the country.

Further, MSDE through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) has facilitated the setting up of Agriculture Skill Council of India (ASCI), an industry led body, to develop National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) aligned job roles and course curriculum, conduct skill gap studies and assess and certify trainees exclusively in Agriculture and ancillary sector. The courses are being designed/developed based on the demand and requirement of industries and youth of the country including youth from marginalized section and backward areas.

Under PMKVY, since inception i.e., 2015 till 30.06.2023, 9.68 lakh candidates have been trained/oriented under Agriculture and ancillary sector in various job roles such as Bamboo Grower, Bee-Keeper, Citrus Fruit Grower, Dairy Farmer/Entrepreneur Level 4, Floriculturist, Organic Grower, Quality Seed Grower, Mushroom Grower, Soyabean Cultivator, Tea Plantation Worker, etc.

Under JSS, since 2018till 30.06.2023, 41,305 candidates have been trained in agriculture sectors in job roles such as Animal Health Worker, Beekeeper, Mushroom Grower (small entrepreneur), Nursery worker, Dairy Farmer/Entrepreneur, Organic Grower, etc.

In long term training, Directorate General of Training (DGT), MSDE is implementing Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) at Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in various sectors including agriculture sector across the country. From 2018 to 2022, 1024 candidates have been trained in ITIs in agriculture sector.

- (c) Under PMKVY, short duration skill development training is being provided to youth to make them employable for better livelihood. PMKVY has two training components namely, Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Placement opportunities are being facilitated to STT certified candidates, while RPL is not linked with placements as it recognizes the existing skills of candidate. The State/UT-wise candidates reported placed under PMKVY-STT in various sectors including Agriculture sector, in last three years i.e., 2020-23, across the country including State of Rajasthan are given at *Annexure*.
- (d) MSDE is coordinating with Private and Public Sector Undertakings to promote skill development. Private companies and Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) under their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) provide funds to National Skill Development Fund (NSDF) for implementing various skill development projects through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC). Since 2014-15 till 30.06.2023, Rs. 169.28 Cr. have been received from Private / PSU donors for imparting various skill development projects wherein 1.69 lakh and 1.29 lakh candidates have been trained and certified respectively. Out of certified candidates, around 74 thousand candidates have been reported placed.
