REGULAR TEACHING/NON-TEACHING POSTS IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS

1789. SHRI NAMA NAGESWARA RAO:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) opened during the last five years, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of the number of vacancies of regular teaching and non-teaching posts in KVs during the last five years; and
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to remove the shortage of the teachers and non- teaching staff in KVs?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

- (a) As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, 70 new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) have been opened throughout the country during the last five years (i.e. 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23). State / UT-wise details are annexed.
- (b) The number of vacancies of regular teaching and non-teaching posts in KVs during the last five years are as under:-

(c) The vacancies arise due to retirement, resignation, promotion and additional requirement on account of up-gradation / sanctioning of new streams as well as enhancement of students' strength. Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and efforts are made to fill up the vacancies as per the provisions of the relevant recruitment rules. Teachers are also engaged on contractual basis for temporary duration by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) to ensure that the teaching-learning process is not hampered. As per the information received from KVS, advertisements for filling up of 13411 vacant posts of teaching and Non-teaching staffs (up to the year 2023) through direct recruitment had been notified in December, 2022.
