ROAD CONNECTIVITY IN TELANGANA AND ANDHRA PRADESH

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(a) whether the Government has dedicated various National Highway projects for improving road connectivity of both Telangana and Andhra Pradesh and also to other connecting States;

(b) if so, the details of surveys/feasibility reports;

(c) the funds sanctioned/spent on the same and progress made so far;

(d) the actual demands of roads by the various States considered/rejected along with the reasons therefor; and

(e) the details of plan of action proposed to meet the future needs of various States in construction of NHs?

(a), (b) & (c) Ministry has taken up various National Highway projects for improving road connectivity of both Telangana and Andhra Pradesh and also to other connecting States viz., Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh and Odisha. The details of such projects, sanctioned based on survey/feasibility/technical reports during the last 3 financial years (i.e., F.Y. 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23) including funds sanctioned for these projects and the progress of expenditure are at Annexure.

(d) & (e) Development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) is a continuous process. Projects to be taken up in successive years are finalized based on the outcome of DPRs, traffic volume, inter-se-priority and availability of resources. The demands for development of NHs received from the states are considered based on the approved Annual Plans.
