**Allocation of Funds for Higher Education**

†1820. SHRI RAJIV RANJAN SINGH ALIAS LALAN SINGH:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the allocation of funds by the Central Government to the States for education sector particularly for Higher Education during the last five years, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government discriminates against States in providing loans for Higher Education; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

(DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a): States have been allocated funds under Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Department of Higher Education namely- Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) and Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP). The objective of RUSA is to improve access, equity and quality in higher education through planned development of higher education at the state level. In order to improve the quality of technical education in State institutions in selected States, TEQIP was formulated. The scheme wise allocation during the last five years is attached at Annexure-I.

(b) to (c) : Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA) Scheme had been formulated to step up investment in creation of quality infrastructure in Centrally Funded Higher Educational Institutions (CFHEIs). Under the scheme, centrally funded institutions submit the project and funds are provided through loans on project basis. As the scheme is meant for Centrally Funded Institutions, there is a no discrimination.
