KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN KERALA / EDUCATION TO TRIBAL POPULATION

1838. SHRI THOMAS CHAZHIKADAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Kendriya Vidyalayas run by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan in Kerala at present, district-wise;
- (b) the number of new Kendriya Vidyalayas constructed and started during the last three years in the country, State-wise especially in Kerala;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that a section of our society particularly tribal areas in the country still do not have access to education; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the relevant details of the steps taken by the Government to increase the access to education to tribal population?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

- (a) At present, 38 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are functioning in the State of Kerala. District-wise details are at **Annexure-I.**
- (b) As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, during the last 3 years (i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23), construction of 63 KVs buildings have been completed and construction of 94 KVs building have been started in the country. State / UT-wise details are at **Annexure-II.**
- (c) & (d) As per information received from Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA), the Ministry is administering the central sector scheme of Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) to provide quality Upper Primary, Secondary, and Senior Secondary level education (Class 6th to 12th) to Scheduled Tribe (ST) students in remote tribal areas to enable them to access the best opportunities in

education and to bring them at par with the general population. National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), an autonomous organization under MoTA, manages and implements the scheme of EMRS. Government has decided to establish one EMRS in every block with more than 50% ST population and at least 20,000 tribal persons, subject to availability of suitable land to be provided by the State/UT Government. At present, a total number of 694 EMRSs have been sanctioned, out of which 401 schools are reported to be functional benefitting about 113275 tribal students.

The Pre-Matric Scholarship and Post – Matric Scholarship Schemes are Centrally Sponsored Schemes implemented by Ministry of Tribal Affairs to grant scholarship to eligible ST students for studying in India whose family income is not exceeded Rs 2,50,000 per annum for pursuing education in Classes IX and X and at post matriculation or post-secondary stage respectively so that the incidence of drop-out, especially in transition from elementary to secondary stage as well as to secondary stage to post-secondary stage is minimized and to enable them to complete their education. The scholarship is awarded by the Government of the State/Union Territory to which the applicant belongs as per the terms of domicile decided by the State/UT and the Scholarship has been directly transferred to the account of the student concerned. Further, the Department of Schools Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education is the nodal Department for providing Universal access to quality education to ST students through its Autonomous/Statutory Bodies, i.e. CBSE, KVS, JNV, NIOS and NCTE and its centrally sponsored scheme of Samagra Shiksha, PM Poshan, Padhna Likhna Abhiyan and central sector scheme of National Means cum Merit Scholarships.
