TRAINING TO RURAL YOUTH IN DIFFERENT TRADES

1840. SHRI DHARMENDRA KASHYAP:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to impart training to rural youth in different trades and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise?

(b) whether the Government proposes to set up training centres in every Parliamentary Constituency for providing training to youth and if so, the number of sectors included in it; and
(c) whether the Government proposes to provide training to women separately and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) Under the Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers Skilling, Re-Skilling and Up-Skilling services for the youth across the country, including women and those in rural areas, through an extensive network of skill development Centres/ Institutes under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). Details of trained candidates under these schemes are at **Annexure-I.**

Apart from above, more than 20 Central Ministries are implementing skill development programmes through various schemes, such as Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), the Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETI) under Ministry of Rural Development, Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) under Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs etc.

(b) The skill development programmes of MSDE are demand driven. In order to fulfill the current demand of skilling, MSDE has taken initiative towards establishment of model aspirational skill centres known as 'Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK)' in each and every district of the country to provide training in 37 Sectors. Additionally, a network of 14,938 ITIs (Government and private) providing skill training in over 33 Sectors and 288 training centres under JSS providing training in 11 sectors have been established.

(c) As stated above, training under the skill development programmes is provided to all the sections of the society including women, with specific provisions for encouraging participation of women. During last three years (2020-21 to 2022-23), women constituted about 34% of total candidates trained, under schemes of MSDE with share of women being as high as 81.05% and 46.43% under short term training programmes, namely JSS and PMKVY respectively.

Further, National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) also offer courses under Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through 33 NSTIs across the country, which includes 19 NSTIs which are exclusively for women. In addition, 30% of the seats in General Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) are reserved for women trainees subject to the general reservation policy of the respective State.
