**ASSESSMENT OF CROP LOSS**

**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

**(a) whether any assessment of losses caused to farmers due to floods has been made in the flood affected districts of the country;**

**(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;**

**(c) the name of the crops which have been identified with maximum damage; and**

**(d) whether any scheme has been formulated to provide financial assistance to the farmers for the said losses and if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) to (c): District-wise and crop-wise information of each State affected by natural disasters, including flood is not maintained centrally by this Ministry. However, state-wise detail of the crop area affected due to hydro-meteorological calamities, including flood, during 2023-24 (as on 26.07.2023), as reported by the State Governments/ Union Territories, is at Annexure.**

**(d): The extant norms of the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF)/ National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF) inter-alia provide for assistance to the farmers in the form of agriculture input subsidy (where crop loss is 33% and above) for damage caused to all types of agriculture/ horticulture crop areas due to the notified natural disasters.
