(a) whether the Government maintains a record of the number of automobiles manufactured in India complying with the BS-VI standards in FY 2022-23;

(b) if so, the details in particular for two and three-wheelers for FY 2022-23 and if not, the reasons therefor;

(c) whether the Government has issued any SOP/directive for private bus operators, cab aggregators and States to phase out vehicles as per existing BS-6 emission norms; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) and (b) Yes Sir. The number of two and three-wheelers registered with the BS-VI Standards in FY 2022-23, as per centralized vehicle record - VAHAN 4.0, are as follows:
