**Blue Revolution Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries Programme**

(a) to (c): The Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries was implemented by the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying for a period of five years from 2015-16 to 2019-20 and a total sum of Rs.2577.58 crore was released for holistic development of fisheries in all States and Union Territories including Jharkhand. During the implementation of the Blue Revolution scheme in the said period, the Department of Fisheries has accorded approval to various fisheries development projects of Government of Jharkhand at the total outlay of Rs. 78.72 crore involving central share of Rs. 39.47 crore for development of fisheries and aquaculture in all districts of State. The approved projects include Finfish Hatcheries, Re-circulatory Aquaculture System(RAS), Ice Plants and Cold Storages, cages/pens in reservoirs and other open water bodies, Fish post-harvest transportation/ fish marketing kiosks units, welfare related activities such as construction of fishermen houses, insurance coverage to fishers , skilling and capacity building of fish farmers. As reported by the Government of Jharkhand, 145 and 79 nos of cage-battery, 23 and 17 nos of Riverine Fish Farming (RFF)/ pen-culture, 69 nos of fishermen houses each to Hazaribag and Ramgarh districts, respectively were covered under the said Scheme.
