MAKING PANCHAYATS HI-TECH

1983 SHRI SUBHASH CHANDRA BAHERIA:

Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to State:

- (a) whether the Government has any scheme to make Panchayats hi-tech by adding new hi-tech facilities and single window solution oriented in the State of Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of Gram Panchayats in Rajasthan where new buildings were constructed during the last nine years; and
- (c) whether the Government has any programme to attach education institutes with Panchayati Raj Institutions to aware students about its functioning?

ANSWER

(a) Under Digital India Programme, Ministry of Panchayati Raj is implementing e-Panchayat Mission Mode Project (MMP), in all the States/ UTs of the country including Rajasthan. The aim is to revamp the functioning of Panchayats and to make them more transparent, accountable and effective. Ministry has launched eGramSwaraj, an accounting application to simplify Panchayat work like planning, accounting and budgeting. Ministry has also integrated eGramSwaraj with Public Financial Management System (PFMS) for Gram Panchayats (GPs) to make real time payments to vendors/service providers. The progress made under eGramSwaraj in the States of Rajasthan for the year 2023-24 is given at **Annexure**.

Further, for attaining the vision of Digital India, BharatNet project is being implemented by Department of Telecommunications in a phased manner to create network to connect all the Gram Panchayats by broadband in the country.

(b) Panchayat being a State subject, providing infrastructural facilities to GPs is primarily the responsibility of States. However, the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of revamped Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) supplements the efforts of States, on a limited scale, by providing financial support for certain infrastructural facilities for GPs such as Gram Panchayat Bhawans, computers and peripherals as proposed by States/UTs in their Annual Action Plan and approved by Central Empowered Committee of RGSA. Under RGSA since its inception 372 Gram Panchayat Bhawans have been approved in Rajasthan.
