DAMAGE CAUSED BY STORMS

2028. SHRI ARVIND GANPAT SAWANT:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the States where storms have occurred during the last three years and the details of damage caused by it, State and year-wise;
- (b) the details of the assistance provided by the Central Government to check and control the same along with compensate the damages/losses during the said period, State and year-wise;
- (c) the damage caused by Toukte, Nisar and other cyclones in Maharashtra and the aid the Government announced to Maharashtra for each of these natural disasters; and
- (d) the details of aid that was disbursed in actual in Maharashtra?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) to (d): As per the information received from various State Governments/UTs and assessed by the Inter-Ministerial Central Teams (IMCTs), details of cyclonic storms struck at various coastal parts of the country during the last three years and damages therefrom, are given at Annexure-I.

As per the National Disaster Management Policy, the primary responsibility

for disaster management, including undertaking assessment of the impact of cyclone, rests with the State Governments concerned. The State Governments provide financial relief to the affected people in the event of notified natural disasters, from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF), already placed at its disposal, in accordance with approved items and norms of Government of India (GOI). However, in the event of disaster of a severe nature, additional financial assistance is extended from the National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF), as per laid down procedure, which includes an assessment based on the visit of an Inter-Ministerial Central Team (IMCT). The financial assistance provided under SDRF and NDRF is by way of relief and not for compensation.

The details of funds allocated and released from SDRF and NDRF during the last three years are given at Annexure-II.

The details of the funds provided from NDRF to the State Government of Maharashtra in wake of Cyclone Nisarga and Tauktae are as under:-

Cyclone	Net amount released from NDRF (Rs. In crore)
Nisarga	268.59
Tauktae	Disaster was not having severe impact in the State. An amount of Rs. 2577.60 crore was available in SDRF Account of Maharashtra during 2021-22 for management of relief activities by natural disasters including cyclonic storm 'Tauktae'. Hence, no amount was released from NDRF.
