- (a) whether the Government is taking any steps for the development of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Poultry farming and the special funds that have been earmarked for the purpose;
- (b) if so, the details of the objectives prescribed thereunder;
- (c) the number of people who have got employment under the said schemes during the last two years in Bihar, Jharkhand, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh;
- (d) the amount allocated for the said purpose during the last year; and
- (e) the details of the scheme being functioning at present?

ANSWER

(a) to (e): Yes, Sir. The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India is presently implementing following schemes and programme for the development of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Poultry farming sectors in the country.

- (i) Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY),
- (ii) Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund(FIDF),
- (iii) Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM),
- (iv) National Livestock Mission (NLM),
- (v) Entrepreneurship Development and Employment Generation (EDEG),
- (vi) Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme (LHDCP),
- (vii) Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF).

The overall objectives of the above-mentioned schemes being implemented by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India are sustainable development of fisheries, animal husbandry and poultry sector in the country while enhancing production and productivity, strengthening requisite infrastructure, infusion and adoption of technologies, aquatic and livestock health and disease management, breed and genetic improvement, promotion of entrepreneurship, participation of private investment, generation of employment etc.

The schemes and programs are being implemented by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India have a large scope for employment generation and income potential. The estimated number of people who have got employment under the said schemes during last two years in Bihar, Jharkhand, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh is 1,41,625.
