Will the Minister of **FISHERIES**, **ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING** मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated for Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana for ecologically healthy and socially inclusive development of the Fisheries sector in the country; and
- (b) the details of fish productivity per hectare in the country?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) and (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing a flagship scheme namely Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) with an investment of ₹20050 crore in all the States and Union Territories (UTs) for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21 to FY 2024-25 for holistic development of the fisheries sector in the country. During the last three financial years (FY 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23), projects worth of Rs. 14654.67 crore with a central share of Rs. 6140.82 crore have been approved and central funds of Rs. 3038.73 crore has been released to various State Governments/Union Territories and other implementing agencies under PMMSY for development of fisheries sector in the country. The Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana being implemented *inter-alia* envisages enhancing the productivity from 3 tonnes/hectare to 5 tonnes/hectare in the country by 2024-25.
