- (a) whether the Government has identified the industries and sub-industries that will be added to the current PM Gati Shakti scheme and if so, the details thereof:
- (b) whether the Government has a tangible plan and methodology laid out in the public domain for the assimilation and collection of firms under the PM Gati Shakti scheme;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government have a plan to include private stakeholders from various firms and industries within the PM Gati Shakti scheme; and

#### **ANSWER**

### वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री सोम प्रकाश) THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

(a) to (e): PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (NMP) was launched in October 2021 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister as a transformative approach for integrated infrastructure development for multi-modal, first and last mile connectivity to the economic nodes and social infrastructure. Planning on NMP brings Ease of Doing Business as well as Ease of Living for the citizens, by enabling seamless movement of people and goods.

As on date, NMP has relevant GIS data layers pertaining to the available infrastructural assets which is being used for planning multimodal infrastructure.

This includes both public and private industrial and other economic assets under the jurisdiction of various Ministries/ Departments of the Centre, States and UT.

As of now, the NMP is available only to authorized Central and State/UT personnel.

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
