Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any representation seeking permission to carry out plantation drive on unutilized barren lands of railway within Western Zone to preserve them from encroachments as well as creating it into social forestry by using Miyawaki method;
- (b) if so, the details and the action taken by the Ministry; and
- (c) if not, the time by which it is likely to be undertaken?

(a) to (c): Proposals/suggestions/representations, both formal and informal, including that from Hon'ble Members of Parliament are received at various levels of Railway Administration viz. Division, Zonal Headquarter and Railway Board's level for beautification and plantation on land including barren land, plantation of trees using Japanese Miyawaki Technique and plantation of Bamboo plant etc., a compendium of which is not maintained. The Proposals/suggestions/representations are examined and action thereon as found feasible and justified is taken from time to time as per the extant policies.
