#### **NEW TRAIN BETWEEN KALABURAGI TO BANGALORE**

#### 2272. DR. UMESH G. JADHAV:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from South Western Railway to start a new train between Kalaburagi to Bangalore;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Ministry has also received a request from public representative in this regard and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the number of passengers who travelled between Bangalore to Kalaburagi and Kalaburagi to Bangalore in the last one year?

#### **ANSWER**

- (a) to (c) Requests, including from Hon'ble Member of Parliament, have been received for introduction of new train between Kalaburagi and Bengaluru. Presently, Kalaburagi-Bengaluru sector is being served by 05 pairs of train services. However, introduction of new trains is an ongoing process on Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic justification etc.
- (d) During the Financial year 2022-23, approximately 2000 passengers travelled per day from Bengaluru area to Kalaburagi while approximately 1800 passengers travelled per day from Kalburagi to Bengaluru.
